ACP: Students will be required to complete an ACP during their 4-year high school career. More information on this can be found on the Rice Lake High School Website.

Students should sign up for any required courses they have failed, even if they plan to take summer school.

Note: Students are limited to two study halls in one year.

SOCIAL STUDIES (SO): World History - You must sign up for both terms. **SO5301 & SO5302**
Please note, we are offering AP European History class next year for Juniors and Seniors. This class would meet the World History requirement. If you are interested in the AP European History course, write that in your World History spots.

PHY ED (PH): Students must choose a **minimum** of one term of Phy Ed during their junior or senior year. Athletic Training and Senior Assist **will not** count toward the 1.5 Physical Education credits needed to graduate.

ENGLISH (EN): Students must choose two English classes from the course selections for Juniors and Seniors. If a student selects AP English they do not need to select a second course as AP English is two terms.

MATH (MA): Most four-year colleges require students to complete **Algebra 1, Geometry and Algebra 2** as **minimum math preparation**. **Introductory Geometry** does count toward the 3 credit Math graduation requirement but does not take the place of Geometry requirement for four-year college purposes.

WORLD LANGUAGES (LA): UW-Madison and U of Minnesota have a two-credit minimum foreign language requirement for admission. It is your responsibility to check with colleges for possible foreign language requirements.

FINE ARTS: The University of Minnesota has a 1 credit requirement in the visual/performing arts (choir, band, drawing, painting or ceramics). It is your responsibility to check with colleges for possible fine arts requirements.

SCIENCE (SC): Most four-year colleges require students to have a **minimum** of three credits in science. Veterinary Science and Natural Resources **can** count toward a student's final required credit in the Science area.

INDEPENDENT STUDY Grades 11-12

Independent opportunities are available to any student who meets the following requirement:

- Student has passed all of the pre-requisite coursework with a grade of B or higher/or teacher approval
- Student has articulated post-secondary goal in requested area of independent study
- One teacher recommendation from area of requested independent study that supports:
 - * Student is able to work independently
 - * Student is able to follow safety guidelines and procedures
 - * Student has documented ability to follow school attendance and behavioral expectations
- One teacher recommendation from another teacher that supports:
 - * Student is able to work independently
 - * Student is able to follow safety guidelines and procedures
 - * Student has documented ability to follow school attendance and behavioral expectations
