SCIENCE:
• Students who took IPS Physics and IPS Chemistry as freshmen are required to take Biology Blue and Biology Gold (if not already completed). Students who opted out of IPS Physics and IPS Chemistry and complete Biology Blue and Biology Gold need to complete Chemistry and Conceptual Physics Blue and Gold at some point during high school.
